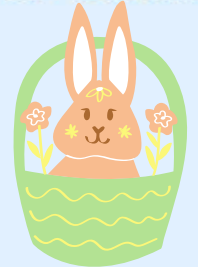

ADLINGTON NEW TOWN UPDATE

The Strategic Environmental Assessment published by the Government on Monday 23rd March announced that the proposal of Adlington as the site of a new town has been deprioritised.

This outcome reflects an enormous amount of work from Poynton Town Council, neighbouring Town and Parish Councils, MP Tim Roca, various campaign groups, and the wider community.

Although Adlington has been deprioritised, the Government have launched a consultation on new town locations and it is important that all residents still respond. Further information will be made available on the Town Council website:
