29 Poynton Pollution Monitoring

An e-mail dated 10th July 2013 had been received from the Senior Enforcement Officer at Cheshire East's Public Protection and Health Dept by the Clerk, concerning funding for the future servicing and maintenance of the air quaility monitor in Poynton. Members agreed that we should in principle offer to fund this, and that it would be cheaper to retain it rather than have to replace it in the future. Cllr Mrs J Sewart said it was important to keep it, in the light of the potential impact of the planned A6 to Manchester Airport Relief Road on local emissions, and that we should budget for its upkeep. Cllr L Clarke added that we might need it to provide solid eveidence on future emission levels. It was further agreed that Cheshire East Councillors should approach the SEMMMS team with a view to them funding or part-funding the future cost of the unit.

RESOLVED: That members agreed in principle to take on the monitor, and to liaise with Cheshire East accordingly; that Cllr P Hoyland be asked to see whether funding or part-funding of the monitor could be obtained from SEMMMS, given that traffic flows through the village will change with the new road; and that a proper SLA is requested from Cheshire East concerning the monitor (NC)

30 Gypsy, Traveller, Travelling Showpeople Accomm. Assessment

Correspondence dated 26th June 2013 had been received from Adrian Fisher, Corporate Manager Economic Intelligence and Spatial Planning at Cheshire East, concerning a study to identify potential gypsy, traveller and travelling showperson sites in Cheshire East. Members had no comment to offer on the proposed methodology of the study, nor were they aware of any suitable sites in Poynton.

RESOLVED: That the Clerk responds to Cheshire East, stating that the Town Council has no views on the study methodology, that the Town Council is not aware of any suitable sites in Poynton, but that if it is incorrect in this then Cheshire East are to advise accordingly (NC)
