12 Questions from members of the public

Mr Andrew Jolley, Glastonbury Drive, attended the meeting to raise his concern about the group of residents who have been raising money to build a play area on a portion of protected Green Belt which in his opinion is contrary to planning law that without planning permission. Mr Jolley felt this was a breach of bye laws for land has been left in trust to be maintained as open space in Poynton. Mr Jolley said the bye laws should be adhered to and this area is an important wildlife corridor to Poynton Brook. He claimed that branches have been removed and dumped into Poynton Brook by the group proposing the play area. Mr Jolley added that there are protected birds in that area and there is a duty of care to the wildlife. The habitat has already been disturbed by the SEMMMS road building work and there is further encroachment from the proposed work to the play area.

A member of the committee shared with Mr Jolley the recent email from Mr Farrell, Cheshire East (CE) Enforcement Officer, which states that the play area has been allowed under permitted development rights. Also play areas can be allowed in the Green Belt as a positive use of Green Belt. It was further explained to Mr Jolley that the Town Council are an advisory body with CE as the decision making body and the correct process has been followed by CE.

Mr Jolley strongly disagreed and was advised to write to CE if he wishes to raise the issue further. RESOLVED: That the proposal as stated is approved (NC)
