44 Neighbourhood Plan Update

Cllr Podmore informed the committee members that the Neighbourhood Plan is in a first draft format.

RESOLVED: That the verbal update on the Neighbourhood Plan from Cllr Podmore is received. That the letter from Cllr Ainsley Arnold, Cabinet Member for Housing and Planning, Cheshire East dated 3rd August 2016 is received (NC)

45 Cheshire East Local Plan Strategy Update

Mr John Knight noted that there are continuing and on-going developments relating to the Cheshire East Local Plan Strategy and today four more reports have been published on the Cheshire East website. Mr Knight provided an update on the keys points from the reports:

The Housing Position Statement seeks to explain the justification for the number of the houses that have been completed and lost since 2010/2011. For Poynton this comes to a net sum of plus 20. Mr Knight clarified that this does not include all the properties which are known to have been developed. There is now proposed phasing shown for the strategic sites. For the three strategic sites in Poynton, of the total 450 dwellings, 235 will be built in the first five years with the remaining 215 dwellings to be built in the following five years.

Also shown is phasing for additional sites such as the North Cheshire Growth Village (east of Wilmslow).

In relation to the Duty to Cooperate report it is evident from documentation that Stockport Borough have not received a satisfactory response concerning the impact of traffic management.

Mr Knight added that it is likely that if the plan is approved by the Inspector then developments will happen very quickly.

It was proposed that the draft report from Mr John Knight is received and that in light of the new information changes are approved under the delegation of powers to the Chair and Vice Chair to approve the final draft for submission to Cheshire East.

RESOLVED: That the draft report from Mr John Knight is received. That delegated powers are given to the Chair and Vice Chair to approve the final draft for submission to the Inspector and Cheshire East.

RESOLVED: That the email from Cheshire East to the Town Clerk dated 27th July 2016 regarding the Examination of Cheshire East Local Plan Strategy - Schedule of Matters, Issues and Questions for Examination is received (NC)

Following consideration of the email dated 4th August 2016 from Kerry Trueman, Cheshire East, to the Town Clerk regarding the Cheshire East Local Plan Strategy Proposed Changes Examination Hearing and the attached Proposed Changes, Examination - Hearing Sessions Programme it was proposed that Mr John Knight would draft a guide on the proceedings of an Examination Hearing to enable and encourage residents that may wish to attend and better understand the process.

RESOLVED: That the correspondence is received. That Poynton is scheduled to be discussed on the 11th and 12th October 2016 is noted. That Mr Knight will produce a short guide on the hearing and what to expect (NC)

The committee members considered a report from Clir Laurence Clarke commenting on the Cheshire East document 'Poynton Final Site Selection Report' (ref PC B018, published July 2016) and from discussion agreed the following points:

The Chairman will emphasise the background to the report and add an introduction to the report to explain that this information is based on an understanding of Poynton and the local area with a consensus around the public experience and engagement with the community.

Page 7 - to amend Greenfield to Greenbelt.

Point 8.37 - to add a quote from the MPPF.

To include the lack of car parking as a major issue in Poynton.

To emphasise the Poynton Town Council Brownfield first policy.

To emphasise the impact on the infrastructure and mitigation as part of any planning permission.

Members agreed that the Town Council should continue to submit evidence to the Inspector on behalf of the community of Poynton."

It was proposed that the Chairman redraft the report and delegated powers are given to the Vice Chairman/Cllr Mrs Sewart to approve the report in light of the discussions and the amended report is sent to Cllr Bailey and the Inspector.

47 Nelson Pit Visitor Centre Car Park

Cllr Mrs Saunders has met with CE Officers and the Portfolio Holder, Cllr Paul Bates, to try and dissuade CE from introducing charges at Nelson Pit Visitor Centre Car Park. Despite these efforts charges at the car park have been introduced. Cllr Mrs Saunders as part of her discussions has pointed out the lack of parking enforcement in Poynton which is supported by the CE data. CE have stated that there will be parking enforcement in Poynton during the weekend. Cllr Mrs Saunders noted the potential impact of displaced parking on Shrigley Road as a result of the introduction of the car park

charges. Also for occasions such as weddings and funerals held at St Martins Church the users are asked to inform the Ranger with regard to car parking at Nelson Pit. The charges will have an adverse impact on the Mary Sunley Canal Boat Trust, a local charity.

Members also noted the letter sent on behalf of the Town Council to Clir Bates dated 21st July 2016 regarding the introduction of charges.
