Pay scale rises from NJC LC1 SCP 20 – 25 (currently £19,430 to £22,658pa) for the Council Community Support Officer and SCP 27 to 32 (currently £24,174 to 28,485pa) for the Supervisor Council Community Support Officer, depending on experience. A potential pay rise is due in April 2018.

You'll usually work 37 hours a week on day shifts, including weekends and bank holidays. Shifts usually cover the hours between 8am and midnight.

You'll mostly be outdoors, patrolling residential areas on foot or bike. You may also work indoors, for example when giving talks to community groups and schools. You'll be provided with a uniform. The post is subject to Police and DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) vetting.
