SPOT POYNTON WILDLIFE WITH POYNTON TOWN COUNCIL

Poynton Town Council want to protect and promote biodiversity in Poynton. In order to do this we need to understand what species we have in the Town. We are promoting the free iNaturalist app, and encouraging people to spot what they can and add these to the app under our project – **Poynton Biodiversity Plan.** We will use the observations from contributors to identify potential projects to improve biodiversity and areas in the Town that require additional support to promote and protect the biodiversity that we have.
