

DOUGLAS CECIL PERRY

C/JX260588 Ordinary Seaman Douglas Cecil Perry, HMS Sultan, Royal Navy.

Born in 1909 at Clacton- on- Sea, Essex, son of cotton buyer for a wholesale house, George Robert and Maud Mary (nee Brooke) Perry of Fallowfield, Manchester. In 1911 the family were resident at 2 Royal Parade Mansions, Colney, Hatch End, Muswell Hill, London.

Douglas died in war service on Monday, 16th February 1942, aged 32 years.

HMS Sultan was an accounting shore base on Singapore Island which fell to the Japanese in February 1942.
