

ERIC TIMPERLEY

466711 Pilot Officer Eric Timperley, 161, Squadron, Royal Air Force.

Born 25th May 1910 at Romiley, son of felt hat shaper, Samuel and Harriet Annie (nee Higgingbottom) Timperley of 16 Barracks Hill, Romiley, his siblings at that time were Arthur Bertram, Wilfrid and Elsie.

Eric married Phyllis Holmes in the summer of 1938, registered at Chapel-en-le-Frith, Derbyshire. They lived at 24 Hilton Road, Higher Poynton. In 1939 Eric was employed as a railway clerk.

In September 1944, Stirlings were received for supply dropping, whilst the Squadron's Lysanders operated into fields in France. On 2nd June 1945 the Squadron disbanded.

Pilot Officer Eric Timperley died on war service on Wednesday 14th February 1945, aged 34 years and is commemorated at Stockport Crematorium, Cheshire.
