MOBILE HOUSEHOLD WASTE AND RECYCLING CENTRE (HWRC)

A reminder that the mobile waste and recycling service is still available in Poynton following the closure of the permanent HWRC.

BOOKING YOUR PLACE AT THE MOBILE WASTE AND RECYCLING CENTRE

Note: The mobile HWRC is managed by Cheshire East Council.

Follow the link to the Cheshire East page: bit.ly/HWRCBOOK

Scroll down and click 'book a slot before you visit'

On the next page, click the 'book a slot' button. This will take you to your log in page for your Cheshire East account. Enter your details.

You will be taken to a page detailing your waste management services, such as the bins you own and whether you are part of the Garden Waste service.

Scroll down and click 'Book Recycling Centre'

You can now check availability of the service and book your place via the interactive calendar.

Sessions are every four weeks and booking opens 30 days in advance.

The mobile site is based off Anson Road, Poynton, SK12 1TD (on part of the original HWRC site.) This service is available every four weeks at the weekend, with a prebooking system in place 30 days before.

If you are unsure how to book your place, please see the instructions on the left.

Poynton Town Council understands that this service is not always easy to access, and finding availability can be a challenge. If you are continuing to face issues with booking, please let us know so that we can collate feedback for Cheshire East, who manage the mobile service.








TOWN COUNCIL OPERATIONS TEAM MAKE IMPROVEMENTS
