NEW IMPROVED 391/891 BUS SERVICE BEGINS 31ST MARCH

Following a collaboration between Poynton Town Council, Bollington Town Council, Pott Shrigley Parish Council, Adlington Town Council, Belle Vue Buses and Cheshire East, we are pleased to announce that a new enhanced bus service begins on 31st March 2025.

A round table discussion took place last year using your views on the frequency of the service, taken from the survey that was conducted. An hourly service for the 391/891 bus route between Middlewood-Poynton-Stockport (via Stepping Hill Hospital) will commence on 31st March 2025 as a result of the negotiations. A two-hourly service will be maintained between Poynton and Macclesfield to the South.

Thank you to all who submitted their comments and although not all the changes we asked for were agreed, the Town Council feel that this is a good compromise and should resolve the majority of the issues raised to us during the survey.
