Covid-19 and supporting vulnerable residents in Poynton

Following the Prime Minister's address on the 4th January, we understand that there will be some Poynton residents who will fall under the 'clinically extremely vulnerable' category mentioned and have been told they now must shield. We would encourage these residents who have family, friends or neighbours who can help with essential medication and shopping, to ask them for support.

We are aware however there may be some clinically extremely vulnerable residents who do not have such support systems and Poynton Town Council will do what we can to support.

If you supported a neighbour previously, and are able to do so again now, perhaps you might like to re-establish those connections and offer assistance by organising essential shopping, medication deliveries or a friendly telephone call to check they are okay.

If you are supporting family, friends or neighbours please continue to observe the Government guidance around social distancing and hygiene measures, being extra mindful of the increased transmissibility of the new strain of Covid-19.
