

NORMAN PENDLEBURY

1507479 Sergeant Norman Pendlebury, 100 Squadron Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve.

Born 8th October 1921 at Poynton, son of Arthur and Jessie (nee Jodrell) Pendlebury of 30 Chester Road, Poynton.

In 1939, Norman was employed as an assistant costing clerk at a plasterboard manufacturer.

Norman died on war service on Tuesday 24th August 1943, aged 21 years.

In December 1942, 100 Squadron reformed at Grimsby as a Lancaster Squadron in No 1 Group with this type of plane. This Squadron took part in night bomber offensives against Germany until the end of the war.
