GATEWAY SHINE UP

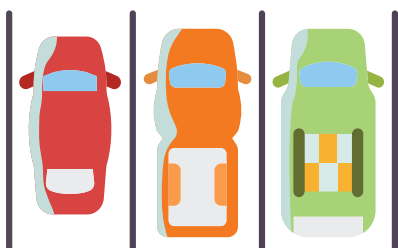

STREETLIGHT REPLACEMENTS

At a meeting on the 3rd of June the Facilities, Infrastructure and Economic Development Committee agreed to replace nine street lights on Warren Lea, Towers Road, Dale House Fold, Green Lane and Middlewood Road with solar powered streetlights. The replacement is as a result of the outcome of the Town Council's street light risk assessment which identified these lights as a priority for replacement. Switching to solar powered lights will also reduce the Town Council's energy costs and its carbon footprint. The tender process has begun and will close on the 16th Sept 2024.
