



### Poynton Town Council precept for 2024/2025

The Town Council sets an annual precept as part of the Council Tax to help pay for the many local services we provide. The Council has worked hard to keep the precept low and made savings wherever possible.

The Town Council's precept for 2024/25 is £595,504, an increase over the current year of £44,518. This equates to an increase of £5.89 (6.57%) per year (just 11 pence a week) for a Band D home. For more detail, please visit <https://www.poyntontowncouncil.gov.uk/>
