Poynton Update and News, 28th June 2023

Exercise of public rights and publication of unaudited Annual Governance and Accountability Return - accounts for the year ended 31st March 2023

Residents have the right to inspect the Town Council's accounting records. Each year, the Annual Governance and Accounting Return (AGAR) needs to be reviewed by the external auditor (PKF Littlejohn LLP), appointed by Smaller Authorities' Audit Appointments Ltd. The unaudited AGAR and Statement of Elector's Rights was published on the website with the formal notice on Friday 23rd June. As it has yet to be reviewed by the appointed auditor, it is subject to change as a result of that review.

Any person interested has the right to inspect and make copies of the accounting records for the financial year to which the audit relates and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers, receipts and other documents relating to those records must be made available for inspection.

These documents are available by appointment with Mrs Haf Barlow, Town Clerk, from Monday 26th June 2023 to Monday 4th August 2023.

Library proposal

The Town Council is extremely concerned about the proposed reduction of opening hours at Poynton library. The proposal is for the library to close all day Thursday and for half a day on Friday.

Poynton Pool spillway update

Representatives from the Town Council and Friends of Poynton Pool made representations to the Cheshire East Economy and Growth Committee on the 6th June. Bus support consultation

Cheshire East Council have launched a consultation regarding bus routes that are not seen as commercially viable by bus operators but are still deemed as important to run. In Poynton, this is the 391 or 392.

The council is asking for views on three new criteria. They are: **Contribution to carbon reduction**, **areas of deprivation** covered by the bus route; and **passenger numbers since the Covid pandemic**.

Former Vernon Infants School

Cheshire East Council is consulting with the Poynton local community over the potential disposal of a parcel of playing field at The Former Vernon Infant School. Specifically, a strip of playing field which is to the rear of the former school building. Any playing field disposal of land on a school site requires approval by the Secretary of State under Section 77 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998. As part of the application process the Secretary of State requires that a period of consultation is undertaken prior to any submission. The period of consultation is 7 weeks. 




