## POYNTON POOL SPILLWAY IMPROVEMENTS: UPDATE

On the 24th of April, Cheshire East's Strategic Planning Board agreed to defer the Poynton Pool Planning application. In order to:

1. Consider and update where necessary any inaccuracies in the submitted data to ensure modelling is accurate.
2. Review the current condition and risks associated with the existing dam wall, and the impact caused by removal of trees on the dam.
3. Instigate a further independent view, if necessary.
4. Review the location of the proposed mitigation and consideration of any alternatives. They also stated that they would encourage engagement with third parties to consider / explain alternatives.

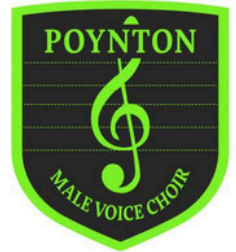


## COMING UP: POYNTON MALE VOICE CHOIR SUMMER CONCERT
