Happy Easter from Poynton Town Council

MOTHBALLING OF POYNTON HOUSEHOLD WASTE AND RECYCLING CENTRE

Cheshire East Council has given an update on its household waste recycling centres. “The emergency closure of Bollington, Poynton and Middlewich Household Waste and Recycling Centres is currently targeted to take place in the next two to three months. Cheshire East Council is working to ensure that the transition is as smooth as possible and as part of this, will be putting in place mitigation measures. Mitigation measures will include later mid-week evening opening hours, transferring existing staff to manage the increased service demands at peak times, and the introduction, on a trial basis, of a mobile household waste recycling service for residents in the Bollington, Poynton and Middlewich areas. The final details of these mitigation measures continue to be developed but will be timed to go live at the same time to limit any disruption as much as possible. Further information will be shared by Cheshire East Council over the coming weeks. For now, all HWRCs in Cheshire East can be accessed as normal.”

POYNTON LEISURE CENTRE UPDATE

The future of the Leisure Centre was discussed by the **Cheshire East Council's** Environment and Community Committee on Monday 11th March 2024. Whilst there are no current proposals to close the Leisure Centre in the short term, the long term future of the leisure centre is still in doubt. Despite other centres which have previously benefited from millions spent on them, Poynton has yet again been denied capital funding. Without investment, **Poynton Town Council** remains concerned that the long term future of the leisure centre will not be viable and Cheshire East Council will revisit site closures. Poynton Town Council has set up a Working Group of councillors and residents with specialist skills to investigate how we can secure the long term future of the leisure centre.
