**1802798 Sergeant Reginald James Doughty, 101, Squadron,
Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve.**

Born in 1923, son of George and Edith Doughty.

Reginald married Joan Evans in the summer of 1944, registered at Macclesfield.

Reginald was serving as a Flight Engineer; he died on war service on Wednesday 11th October 1944 aged 21 years.

101 Squadron were re-equipped with Lancaster bombers in October 1942 and a year later began operating counter-measure equipment, a role which lasted until the end of the war.

Sergeant Reginald James Doughty is buried at Adegem Canadian War Cemetery, Oost-Vlaanderen, Belgium.
