APPLICATION FOR TENANCY OF AN ALLOTMENT GARDEN

Poynton Town Council's allotment site is situated off Coppice Road, Higher Poynton, and is administered jointly with the site plot-holders' association. There are 50 plots of varying area, from around 200 sqm. down to approximately 60 sqm., with the majority averaging 80 sqm. These are available to rent by all residents of the Council, although they are very popular and have a waiting list for tenancy.

If you were to become an allotment tenant you would need to complete a tenancy agreement, and comply with all its terms and conditions, pay an initial deposit equivalent to two years rental, refundable upon leaving the plot in a satisfactory state, cultivate the plot to the required standard and pay an annual rental and subscription fee for membership of the plot-holders' association. Joint tenancies are available.

If you would like to apply to go on the waiting list, please complete this form and return it to Poynton Town Council for the attention of the Town Clerk.

The waiting list is managed on a first come, first served basis, according to date of receipt of application with no exceptions.

When you are offered an allotment plot, you are given one refusal opportunity. If you refuse a second plot you will be removed the list.
