

ALBERT GREEN

199719, Gunner, Albert Green, 126th Siege Battery, Royal Garrison Artillery.

Born in 1896 at Poynton, son of coal miner hewer, John and Mary Green of 219 Park Lane, Poynton, Cheshire.

There were three boys and five girls in the family. Albert was the eldest child. His siblings were Edith, William, Elsie, Marion, Sarah Isabella, Joseph and Annie. In 1911, at the age of 14 years, Albert was working as a coal miner labourer.

He enlisted at Stockport, and after his gunnery training at Gosport, he was drafted with the British Expeditionary Force to France. He died of wounds received from friendly fire on the 11/10/1918. He was aged 22 years.
