

GEORGE F.A. LORD VERNON

Captain, Lord George Francis Augustus Vernon, Derbyshire Yeomanry. Born 28 September 1888 at

Stockport, son of George William Henry Warren-Venables-Vernon, the 7th Baron of Sudbury, Derbyshire. Educated at Stone House College, Eton, and Oxford. Lord Vernon received his commission into the Derbyshire Yeomanry in 1906.

He subsequently was promoted to Lieutenant in June 1912, and to Captain in September 1914. Lord George died, 10/11/1915, aged 27 years, of dysentery in St Andrew's Hospital, Malta, after serving in Gallipoli.



Medals: British War Medal and Victory Medal.

These were sent to his brother, Lord Vernon, at Sudbury Hall, Derbyshire. Probate of his Will was to Rt Hon Francis Lawrence William Vernon, Baron Vernon and Sir Henry Arthur White, Knight C.V.O. Effects: £6,5420.9s.8d.
