

ROBERT POOLE

1468, Driver, Robert Hartley Poole, Royal Field Artillery.

Born in 1891 at Poynton, son of coal hewer John Henry and Mary Poole who in 1901 were living at Long Row, Park Lane, Poynton. Their address in 1911 was The Village, Poynton. They had a large family of ten children, John Henry, Sarah, George, Laura, Robert Hartley, Ella, Stanley, Walter, Doris and Mildred. Robert was working as a coal mine waggoner when he enlisted at Chester. He was drafted to the Balkans theatre of war. He died of pneumonia in 52nd General Hospital, Salonika, 08/10/1918, aged 27 years.
